

2021 Facility / Other Operations Rate Schedule

Purpose: This document defines various types of facilities and other operations that require State and/or Federal oil spill compliance, and the rates charged for compliance.

Key Definitions

***Capacity:** The total maximum amount of oil or refined products that can be stored in either fuel tanks or cargo tanks in a Facility or other regulated operation. The Capacity is reported for each Facility or other regulated operation seeking oil spill compliance coverage.

Coverage Definitions

- **Facility:** An oil terminal or storage facility that stores oil or refined products in bulk for commercial or on-site consumption that requires oil spill compliance.
 - Inland or River: A facility that would not need marine assets to address an oil spill from its tanks.
 - Shoreside Marine: A facility that would need marine assets to address an oil spill from its tanks that could impact tidally influenced or marine waters.
- **Capacity Guidelines:**
 - Facility: Total capacity per facility.
 - Not-For-Profit, Public Sector facility: Total capacity per ADEC sub-region.
- **Other Operation:** A regulated entity that requires state and/or federal oil spill compliance that is not a Facility or Vessel.
 - Railroad: A company that operates a railroad that carries fuel or oil cargo in bulk.
 - Drilling: A company that explores or drills for oil or gas that requires oil spill compliance.
 - Trucking: Operations that include trucks or trailers that move oil or refine oil in bulk as cargo.
 - Other: Any other operation that requires state and/or federal oil spill response coverage to conduct operations.

Base rate and marine surcharge are multiplied by total maximum capacity to determine charge.

- e.g. For 10,000-bbl facility inland/river, charge is $10,000 \times 0.33 = \$3,300$.
- e.g. For 150,000-bbl facility shoreside marine, charge is $150,000 \times (0.33+0.11) = \$66,000$.

Enrollment Process

- All companies and planholders with existing agreements with Alaska Chadux Corporation and the Alaska Maritime Prevention & Response Network remain in compliance and do not need to resubmit an enrollment agreement at this time.
- Annual renewal or reenrollment is not necessary, as the Certificate of Coverage remains continuously valid from the date of issuance. Payment is due upon receipt of invoice and payable in U.S. dollars per terms of your category nomination.
- Provide information on enrollment form:
 - Identify type of operation (facility type, other).
 - Total oil capacity of operation (fuel, oil cargo, other).
- Upon receipt of the signed enrollment agreement, the requested Certificates of Coverage (Federal and State) will be sent to the identified Planholder and others identified on the enrollment form as appropriate.
- An annual confirmation of coverage notification will be sent out to obtain details on nomination details for the following year.
- Additional Invoicing information:
 - Facilities – Billed upon annual nomination, invoiced quarterly for calendar year compliance.
 - Other – Railroad, Drilling, Trucking, Other – Billed upon annual nomination, invoiced annually for calendar year compliance.
